Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Conference of Minority Transportation Officials (COMTO) Fort Lauderdale 2024 Scholarship Program. Enclosed you will find the Scholarship Application Package that you requested.

The scholarship awarded may be used for study-related expenses such as tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, and transportation.

The scholarships being offered are a one-time award for students enrolled in school in 2024-2025 for:

- **High School Scholarship(s)** in the amount of \$1000 given to selected South Florida minority high school seniors who have been accepted to an accredited college pursuing a transportation-related career.
- **Technical/Vocational School Scholarship(s)** in the amount of \$750 given to selected minority students accepted to attend an accredited vocational, technical, or trade school pursuing a transportation-related career.
- **Transportation Industry College Scholarship(s)** in the amount of \$1,500 given to selected minority students currently attending an accredited college or university in the State of Florida pursuing a transportation-related career.
- **Jack L. Stephens Graduate Scholarship(s)** in the amount of \$2,500 given to selected minority students with a career in transportation, attending an accredited college or university in the State of Florida, in pursuit of a Master's or Doctorate degree.

Not all scholarship types will necessarily be awarded every year. Awards will be presented to applicants who receive the highest score during the evaluation process. The total amount of dollars and quantity of scholarships awarded will be determined by the COMTO Fort Lauderdale Board. The COMTO Fort Lauderdale Board will make the determination of awards based on the quantity and quality of applications received prior to the deadline.

Applicants should ensure that they meet all qualifications before completing and submitting an application package. A complete list of requirements can be found in the Eligibility Requirements section of the application package. The deadline for submitting a complete application package is Friday, **May 4, 2024, at 5:00 PM (EST)**.

COMTO FORT LAUDERDALE 2024 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Program Information

COMTO Fort Lauderdale will award scholarships for the 2024-2025 academic year to students who express an interest in pursuing studies in a transportation-related field. The scholarship award may be used for study-related expenses such as tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, and transportation at an accredited college/vocational-technical institution. All scholarships are being offered for one (1) school year.

High School Scholarship(s)

The High School Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 is given to South Florida minority high school seniors who have been accepted to an accredited college/vocational-technical institution. Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.0 unweighted scale and demonstrate an interest in pursuing a transportation-related career.

Technical/Vocational School Scholarship(s)

The Technical/Vocational School Scholarship in the amount of \$750 is given to selected minority students accepted to attend an accredited vocational, technical, or trade secondary education school, pursuing a transportation-related career.

Transportation Industry College Scholarship(s)

The Transportation Industry College Scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 is given to a minority student attending an accredited college or university in the State of Florida. Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.0 unweighted scale and pursuing a major in a transportation-related career.

Jack L. Stephens Graduate Scholarship(s)

The Jack L. Stephens Graduate Scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 is given to a minority student attending an accredited college or university in the State of Florida, in pursuit of a Master's or Doctorate degree. Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.0 unweighted scale and a major in a transportation-related career.

Eligibility Requirements

Residency: All U.S. citizens or permanent residents who reside in Broward, Miami-Dade, or Palm Beach County. Those that do not reside in these counties but are residents of Florida may be considered if no other eligible candidates qualify.

School Status:

- High School Scholarship – A minority high school senior student in a Broward, Miami-Dade, or Palm Beach County school, in good standing.
- College Scholarship – A minority student enrolled at a secondary education institution in the State of Florida, with a minimum of 12 accumulated credit hours.



Scholarship Application Process

Students interested in applying must submit a complete Scholarship Application and any other required forms to:

To facilitate the process, a checklist is included with the package. Students are responsible for submitting all required supporting material listed on the checklist. Incomplete application packages, or application and supporting material received after the deadline may not be considered. COMTO Fort Lauderdale will not contact students to advise of incomplete packages nor arrange for the submission of missing material.

Scholarship Award Process

Selection of recipients for COMTO Fort Lauderdale Scholarships will be made by the COMTO Fort Lauderdale Scholarship Committee. Scoring will be based on Grade Point Average, Personal Essay, Career Goal Activities, Letters of Recommendation, School Citizenship, and COMTO affiliation. Individual Interviews may be requested if deemed necessary. Recipients will be notified via email and phone.

Recipients of awards will be asked to submit a photo to be included in any announcement of award winners made by COMTO National or COMTO Fort Lauderdale. In addition, scholarship winners will be asked to participate in a Scholarship Awards Luncheon to be scheduled at a future date, or submit a video accepting their scholarship award.
